I am writing to object, most
strongly, to the proposed closing of these above
pedestrian crossings, by Network Rail.

I grew up in Wivenhoe, and have been a
resident for many years, and have used the
E41 Paget Road crossing, Wivenhoe, countless times
over the years. I have never heard of an
accident, or fatality, on either of these crossings.

The railway virtually cuts the village of
Wivenhoe in half, and the E41 Paget Road

crossing conveniently links the older southern part of the village of Wivenhoe, with the newer northern part of the village. Its closure would mean a longer, and potentially more dangerous detour between the two parts of Wivenhoe.

I urge a public inquiry into the planned closure of these two crossings.
