Dear Sir / Madam,

My husband and I are writing to oppose the proposed closure of footpath 189.

We live at [REDACTED]. We use the crossing daily to get to work, visit grandparents, to get to nursery and to take my son to Beavers. My parents live on the [REDACTED] and this would have a massive impact on my mothers ability to visit her grandchildren as she has limited mobility and does not drive. Furthermore to close this access would mean that we would have to rely a lot more on using the car to get to my daughters nursery [REDACTED] and also to get my son to [REDACTED] as it would take about 20 minutes walk rather than 5 minutes.

The crossing has a high footfall and it's closure would see a large impact on the local community. There are two secondary schools on the north side and a large number of pupils use it. Closing the crossing would mean a longer journey time for them and cause huge inconvenience.

We would also question why it has recently been upgraded if your intention is to close it.
